Dr. Dinshaw Pardiwala
Ms(Orth), D.Orth., DNB(Orth), FCPS

Dr. Dinshaw Pardiwala is an orthopaedic surgeon and heads the Centre for Sports Medicine at the Kokilaben Dhirubhai Ambani Hospital, Mumbai. He was the Chief Medical Officer for Team India at the Paris Olympics 2024 and he is also India's representative at the ICC (International Cricket Council) Medical Committee.

His contribution to Indian sports over the past 25 years has been unparalleled and he has had a major role in India earning 9 medals in the past 4 Olympic games. Over 30 athletes that he has operated upon have gone ahead to secure medals for India at Commonwealth Games, Asian Games, and World Championships in different sports in the past decade. 12 of the 30 BCCI contracted players of the Indian men's cricket team for 2024, have undergone surgical procedures or treatment for injuries by him. In a world where sports injuries can end careers, Dr. Pardiwala's surgeries have enabled athletes to turn setbacks into success and he is the go-to doctor for all of India's top athletes, from Sachin Tendulkar to Rishab Pant, and from Neeraj Chopra to Saina Nehwal.

His work in arthroscopic surgery has been internationally published and recognized and he is the recipient of numerous national and international academic awards. In 2009, in Osaka (Japan), he was awarded the most prestigious John Joyce Award by the International Arthroscopy Society (ISAKOS) for his path-breaking research on knee ligament injuries. In 2015, the Health Minister of India awarded him the Swasth Bharat Samman for his pioneering contributions to sports surgery in India.



Dr. Cyrus Karkaria
Excellence in the field of Biotechnology

Cyrus Karkaria, a visionary leader, has been the President of the Biotechnology division of Lupin since 2010. Currently based at Pune, he has over 35 years of rich industry experience in the field of Bio-pharmaceutical drug development while working with multi-national companies based out of US and India.

He has always held the strategic vision of making Lupin a global Bio-pharmaceutical powerhouse, by setting best in class industry benchmarks and global standards of development. Despite being a late entrant to the biosimilars segment, Lupin over the last 14 years under his invaluable guidance has gained significant momentum; thereby leading to streamlining of its vision, enrichment of pipeline products and strengthening of its globalization strategies. He helped create a strong foundation and devised strong in-house capabilities (vial to vial) across the drug development value chain. Under his leadership, regulatory and clinical strategies are formulated with a strong focus on harmonization of global regulatory guidelines and commercialization strategies are designed based on the complex regulatory, IP and competitive landscape. He has been instrumental in establishing a global footprint for Lupin Biotech, by adopting quality framework in line with stringent global norms, adapting quickly to the changing global landscape and reinventing business models by promoting a creative and flexible organization culture.

He has also advised numerous government bodies about biotechnology and is recognized as one of the top biotech professionals in India. Also, having an interest in augmenting biotechnology education in India and abroad, he has served on various scientific advisory boards of colleges.

Before starting the stint at Lupin, he was Vice President at Celldex Therapeutics and CuraGen Corporation in New Haven, Connecticut, USA heading Operations and Biopharmaceutical Process Sciences.

He has also held positions at Biogen and Scios and has been part of teams that have developed blockbusters in the field of neurology, immunology and oncology such as Avonex, Amevive and Tysabri (Biogen Idec). Such background experiences have helped create his expertise and proficiency in the development and commercialization of biological products.

He holds a Ph.D. in Biochemistry from the University of Maryland and was a post-doctoral researcher at the Harvard Medical School.



Dr. Firdosh Gardin

Dr. Firdosh Sorab Gardin is a seasoned pharma professional with over four decades of experience shaping the industry. From pioneering roles at GlaxoSmithKline to leading major operations at Novartis, his career has been a journey of innovation, leadership, and strategic impact.

Armed with a PhD in Physical Chemistry and a Diploma in Management Studies, Firdosh further honed his leadership skills at INSEAD Singapore and ISB Hyderabad. His expertise and forward-thinking approach earned him a Lean Sigma Green Belt certification, solidifying his reputation as a problem-solver in the complex world of pharmaceuticals.

Starting his career at Glaxo in 1983, he spent 27 years navigating diverse roles, culminating in his appointment as General Manager of Contract Manufacturing Sourcing Group – South Asia. His influence expanded further in 2020 when he took charge of Novartis' supply operations across Asia Pacific, Japan, the Middle East, and Africa.

Even after retiring in 2022, his insights remained invaluable. Novartis retained him as a consultant until 2024, and he also played a leading role in OPPI's Technical & Supply Chain work stream. Today, he continues to share his wealth of knowledge as a soughtafter pharma consultant.



Returning to Mumbai in 2011, he established a private practice, gaining recognition in design circles. He was named one of GQ's Most Influential Young Indians 2017 and Hello! 

Annual Report 2024-2025

"Together we shall achieve" This is what the Trust is all about. Its achievements, its accomplishments its result are the Trust's culmination of the efforts of many who helped the Trust to its present status.

The preservation of our Restrictive Covenant and a basic need of survival in the year 1980 saw the birth of the Mancherji Edalji Joshi Memorial Trust.

Since its inception the Trust has undertaken various Fund-Raising Drives such as procuring donations, releasing souvenirs at forty Festival of Spring Jamshedi Navroze Gambhars and three successful Winter Fairs in 1980,1986 and 1989. The proceeds from these drives are credited to the Corpus of the Trust and invested in approved securities and only the interest thereof utilized towards the **CHARITABLE OBJECTS OF THE TRUST.** Today our Corpus stands at 6.31 crores.

The Trust is registered under the BOMBAY PUBLIC TRUST ACT 1950, the Charity Commissioner of Maharashtra State and INCOME TAX ACT, 1961. Ever since its registration the Trust has been issued an ongoing 80G certificate of exemption under the Income Tax Act, thereby establishing its credentials as a well-managed Trust. **Donors qualify for exemption under 80G/10B on all donations to the Trust.**

Accounts of the Trust are audited yearly by our Auditors, C.A. Prakash J. Waghela & Co. All statutory tax returns are filed on a regular basis with The Income Tax Department as well as the Charity Commissioner, Greater Mumbai, Maharashtra State. Persons wishing to peruse the accounts are welcome to do so.

Monetary aid in all three categories is given to the deserving poor. Norms of disbursement are laid down and strictly adhered to. Every applicant needs to go through a personal interview. Credentials are established and only then financial aid is disbursed to the applicant.

Also financial aid to the poor, the needy and the destitute are disbursed by crediting through a bank transfer to his/her Bank A/c directly every quarter.

We sincerely thank the Principal and Management of the Dadar Athornan Institute (Madressa) for permitting the use of their premises for this endeavor and other activities of the Trust.

HOUSES IN GUJARAT:

For over two decades the Trust was funding the building of PUCCA CEMENTED COTTAGES for the needy in the interiors of Gujarat.

Our heartfelt gratitude goes out to MRS. FERZYN BOOMLA for continuing the noble tradition of her mother the Late NAJU DAVER of donating a GARA for the purpose of raising funds for our laudable scheme. Our sincere thanks also go out to THE HOUSE OF GODREJ for year in and year out donating a refrigerator / Home safe / cupboard to raise funds for the above purpose. The monies collected from this effort were in the past utilized towards building one such house every year. It is through the good offices of the World Zoroastrian Organisation Trust that we are able to build these houses for our poor brethren. A marble plaque is embedded at the entrance of every house that is built from this drive. Each plaque clearly states THIS HOUSE IS BUILT FROM THE MONEY COLLECTED BY THE MANCHEJI EDALJI JOSHI MEMORIAL TRUST THROUGH THE GOOD OFFICES OF THE WORLD ZOROASTRIAN ORGANISATION TRUST and the name of the person in whose memory the houses are built in case of individual single donor families

DONATION TO AHURA SUPPORT:

From the last year (2024) the Gara collection funds are being utilized for donations to the "Ahura Support" Institution at Byculla, which runs a facility for the differently abled brethren of our community.

FOOD SCHEME:
